1. By completing this form and joining the event, you agree to the general terms and conditions of Green Laning (found on the North Wales Land Rover Club website) and the following:
2. The convoy leaders are there to guide you during the day. It is solely your choice as to whether you think you or your vehicle are capable of driving the lanes.
3. Green lane days are intended to be non-damaging. By nature, Green Lanes can change each time we drive them. This can be the terrain or foliage. You can expect your vehicle to be subjected to scratches or worse on some of the more challenging lanes. NWLRC accept no liability for any such damage.
4. You take part in the event at your own risk and without liability on the part of the organisers, NWLRC, other participants or the owners of the vehicle in which you travel, for any loss or injury to your vehicle or yourselves or to any minors who may be in your vehicle and you effectually indemnify and absolve the organisers, NWLRC, other participants and land owners from and against

all costs, claims and demands whatsoever arising out of any such loss or injury, personal or otherwise caused by virtue or participation in the event.

5. As the owner of the vehicle taking part in the event, you have full motor insurance cover for the use of the vehicle on public roads as required by the road traffic acts including third party and passenger liability.
6. You must follow the instructions of the leader at all times as well as the Green Lane Code of Conduct. If you can not do this then you may be asked to leave the group.
7. You undertake not to damage any property in participating in the event and to indemnify the organisers, NWLRC, and the land owners from and against any claims for the damage you may cause.
8. Be social Media Aware. Do not post online photographa or videos that may bring the club into disrepute. For instance a photograph of 14 vehicles at a meeting point may draw trolls into thinking we have been running one group of many.
